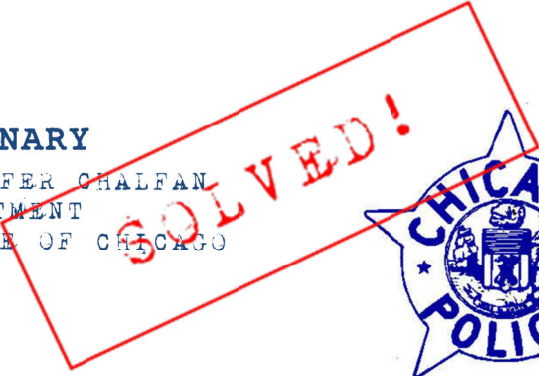


**CASE NAME: PICTONARY**

ANSWER: SUNBLOCK

This puzzle contains groups of drawings from two Pictionary teams, Team 1 and Team 2.

Each team has four drawings in four categories, plus one extra word. Each of the categorized drawings is a sketch of a word that is a homonym or a different meaning of the word that fits in its category.

The final answer is derived by taking a different meaning of the drawing from each team that does not fit into one of the categories.

The extra words, SON and BLOCK, go together phonetically to make the answer, SUNBLOCK
