Answer: CHOW

Each monkey plays Twister by putting each of its hands and feet on circles on the Twister board. When a monkey's hand or foot is placed on a circle, it contributes that letter to the word, forming a new word.

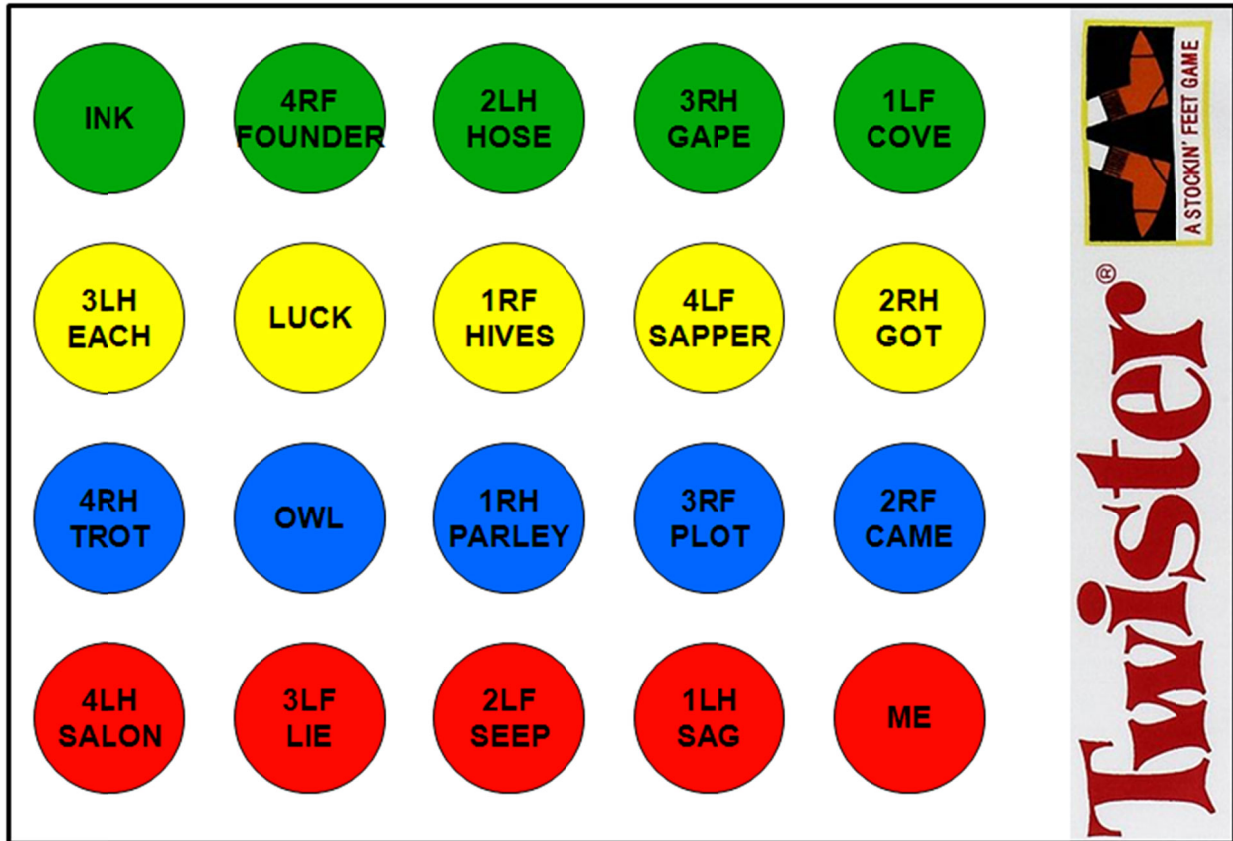
Each monkey is associated with a different category of words.

Starting board:

INK	FOUNDER	HOSE	GAPE	COVE
EACH	LUCK	HIVES	SAPPER	GOT
TROT	OWL	PARLEY	PLOT	CAME
SALON	LIE	SEEP	SAG	ME

Information about each monkey:

Once each monkey is placed covering the four words in its grouping, four words remain, one per line. Read from top to bottom, they are: INK LUCK OWL ME. Each of these words is one letter away from an animal sound: **O**INK **CL**UCK **H**OWL **ME**W. Rearranging these gives the final answer, CHOW.
